WHAT A REFERRED INVENTOR BRINGS YOU, STEP BY STEP

Five gated steps: the FORGE method, proprietary to IPGuru. You approve the evidence at every gate, and each step hands you something real:



A structured invention disclosure.

Built by guided interview before the inventor reaches you: the problem, the solution, the embodiments, the decisions already made.



A documented prior-art record.

A semantic search across 250M+ patents in five translated languages, with what was searched, what was found and what was concluded.



Drafted claims, description and figures.

Plus 3D models and short videos where they help the client, the examiner or the record. Your starting point is a draft, not a blank page.



A mock-examination scorecard.

You see the weaknesses before the first meeting, and the inventor has already seen them too. The weak ideas were filtered out before referral, at no cost to anyone's time but ours.
